Chapter 5

End Time Prophecy

Evidence through the use of gematria which indicates the time when God's final judgment is to occur is not something I was seeking, nor is it the result of ideas generated from my own intellect. On the contrary; it is something that was revealed to me, and I was merely carried along by a wave of inspiration. The way in which I was able to determine the somewhat indistinct time is certainly not anything that I could have come up with on my own. When suddenly I was overcome by the thought of pursuing evaluation of Scripture related to the end times, which had never before been a personal concern, I was drawn back to the Book of Daniel. It was the last few verses in this book of prophecy that led me to the gematria evidence that will be presented. Daniel's prophecy is concerning the end times, and he gives the number of days until the end. The last three verses in the chapter are confusing and do not seem to make any sense. Having learned that all numbers are of significance when it comes to Scripture, and that numbers frequently are symbolic in nature, I took a closer look at the numbers mentioned in Daniel's prophecy.

The last three verses in Daniel Chapter 12 read as follows:

¹¹*And from the time of the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, there shall be **a thousand two hundred and ninety days.***

¹²*Blessed is he that waiteth, and cometh to the **thousand three hundred and five and thirty days.***

¹³*But go thou way till the end: for thou **shalt rest**, and stand in thy lot **at the end of days.***

The words of this prophecy are confusing and appear contradictory in relation to the numbers. How could this ever be deciphered? Perhaps the three verses immediately prior to the three just listed indicate that according to the purpose of God, the fog of confusion would be lifted as the time of the end approaches. These are the words of those verses:

⁸*And **I heard, but I understood not**: then said I, O my Lord, what shall be the end of these things?*

⁹*And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for **the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end.***

¹⁰*Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and **none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand.***

I have a hard time considering myself to be one of the wise who shall understand, but God has chosen others in the past who had faults, but to whom He gave wisdom to serve in order to fulfill His purpose. That purpose presently, is to give warning that the time of judgment approaches. View this idea with extreme skepticism or even derision, but consider closely the gematria evidence to be presented in light of the truth which has already been confirmed by using the

numerical value of words. The time of the end which is determined by gematria is obtained only by using the unchanging value of numbers, not by any individual interpretation of Scripture.

My first impression from reading the prophecy of Daniel was that the number of days listed was very likely a symbolic representation rather than a specific period of time. This idea was reinforced as a result of two different periods of days being mentioned. First, I looked for words with the value of 1290 and 1335 to see if there was any correlation with the end times. For the value **1290**, there were a few words of interest: επιτιμων (rebuke), χρονου (time), κατειδωλον (wholly given to idolatry), αποστησονται (to shun); and for **1335** there were some interesting words as well: κρισεως (judgment), ποποτε (at any time), νικοπολεως (Nicopolis – means “city of victory”). These words seemed to have an association with the end times. There are the words related to **time** and one for **judgment**. In the end God will **rebuke** mankind who is **wholly given to idolatry** in various forms and He will **shun** those who have rejected His Son. For those who are chosen, they will enter the New Jerusalem, a **city of victory**.

Next, I started to put Hebrew words together which relate to the end times to see if I could reach a value of 1290 which is the number of days mentioned in verse 11. I came up with the following words which have the necessary total value.

The secret day of the Lord, the Son of God himself shall return as king = סתר יום יהוה סתב מלך
= 90 + 308 + 12 + 86 + 52 + 26 + 56 + 660 = **1290**

It could certainly be questioned as to validity of such a finding, because with sufficient effort one could likely come up with similar numerical correlations for nearly anything. I therefore began to look at various verses of prophecy regarding the “Day of the Lord.” In Isaiah there is a verse, which with juggling the words a bit, the number recorded in Daniel is found.

And it shall come to pass in that day, that the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come who are ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the Lord in the holy mount at Jerusalem. Isaiah 27: 13.

In the day of the Lord the great trumpet shall blow and I will come = יום יהוה גדול שופר
= 9 + 570 + 586 + 43 + 26 + 56 = **1290**

If this is still not enough evidence to suggest a symbolic meaning of the number 1290 then consider the following which arises from the words of another prophetic verse.

Hold thy peace at the presence of the Lord God: for the day of the Lord is at hand: for the Lord hath prepared a sacrifice, he hath bid his guests. Zephaniah 1: 7.

The day of the Lord is at hand: it shall be the day the Lord prepares a sacrifice and bids his guests = יום יהוה קרב יהיה יום יהוה פון זבח קדש קרא
= 301 + 404 + 17 + 76 + 26 + 56 + 20 + 308 + 26 + 56 = **1290**

Words taken from a verse in yet another book of prophecy related to the day of the Lord’s vengeance also add up to 1290.

And the Lord shall utter his voice before his army: for his camp is very great: for he is strong that executeth his word: for the day of the Lord is great and very terrible; and who can abide it. Joel 2: 11.

And the Lord shall utter his voice before his army: he is strong that executeth his word to destroy = יהוה נתן קול פנים חיל עצום עשה דבר אבד = 7 + 206 + 375 + 206 + 48 + 180 + 136 + 500 + 26 = **1684**

Now, what might you ask does the number 1684 have to do with the 1290 days mentioned in the Book of Daniel regarding the end times? The answer is found in the Greek words for the number 1290.

One thousand two hundred ninety = χίλιοι διακόσιοι ἐνεήκοντα = 730 + 395 + 559 = **1684**

The same proof that 1290 is significant in relation to the end times can be seen using the Hebrew words for the number.

One thousand two hundred and ninety = אלף שנים מאה השעים = 820 + 46 + 400 + 111 = **1377**

Last Sabbath day = אחרית שבת יום = 56 + 702 + 619 = **1377**

With these few examples, it certainly seems that the number 1290 does have some symbolic meaning. What about the other number in the prophecy of Daniel, 1335. This also seems to have symbolism in its value.

The end of time, the last day = עת אחרית יום = 56 + 619 + 470 + 190 = **1335**

Secret last day = סוד אחרית יום = 56 + 619 + 660 = **1335**

Once again it can be shown that by using words from a prophecy of the end times, a slight rearrangement of the words can be used to identify the significance of the number 1335.

*In that day, saith the Lord of hosts, will I take thee, O Zerubbabel, my servant, the son of Sheatiel, saith the Lord, and will make thee as a signet...*Hagai 2: 23.

A signet means “seal or mark.” In Revelation, in addition to the mark of the beast, 666, there is another mark and it says that those who have the mark of God will be protected. This is shown in the example using words from the verse in Hagai.

The day the Father, the Lord of hosts saith, the Son will take my servants and make them a signet = יהוה צבא נאם בן לקח עבד שום חותם = 454 + 346 + 76 + 138 + 52 + 91 + 93 + 26 + 3 + 56 = **1335**

There is another verse in the prophecy of Joel which bears witness to the fact that the number 1335 is significant in regard to the end times.

The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and terrible day of the Lord come. Joel 2: 31.

The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood = שמש הפך חשך ירח דם = 44 + 218 + 328 + 105 + 640 = **1335**

It is written in the Bible that at the last trumpet Jesus will return and all mankind will know that He is God. That will occur after 1335 days.

The trumpet shall blow and all men shall know = שופר נשף כל אדם ידע = 84 + 45 + 50 + 570 + 586 = **1335**

If one should view what I have shown thus far for the two numbers mentioned in Daniel as merely manipulation of the words, then consider the following.

One thousand three hundred and five and thirty days = אלה שלושה מאה חמש שלושים יום = 56 + 686 + 348 + 46 + 636 + 111 = **1883**

The time made desolate, one thousand two hundred ninety days = עת שמם אלה מאה ותשעים יום = 56 + 820 + 46 + 111 + 380 + 470 = **1883**

It seems to me that the numerical value of the words for “1335 days” equal to the value for words describing the end times from the same prophecy using the other number of days mentioned in that same prophetic passage of Scripture, 1290, is simply too much to view as a coincidence. The significance of the numbers is further revealed by words in Greek.

The time (set or proper time) the Messiah will come = Καίρος Μεσσίας ἔρχομαι = 401 + 656 + 826 = **1883**

In Romans it says that there will be a time of judgment and all will bow down and confess to God. *For it is written, as I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue confess to God.* Romans 14: 11. The numbers reveal that it will occur in 1335 days when Christ returns, and all bow down to the Lamb of God.

All shall bow down to the Lamb = Πᾶς κἀμπτω Ἄμνός = 281 + 1241 + 361 = **1883** = value of Hebrew words for one thousand three hundred and five and thirty days.

There is also a single Greek word with the value of 1883 which may be of significance in the determination of the time of the end. That word is γινώσκω which means “**to know**.” This is the second time (see previous discussion of the number 1770) in which a numerical value associated with the end times has a word of that value meaning “to know” or “to make known.” I believe that God had a plan from the beginning to reveal the secret of the time of the end at the proper time, and that time is now.

So it seems that there is symbolism in the numbers mentioned in the prophecy of Daniel regarding the end times. In Revelation there is also a confusing passage which speaks of a specific number of days until the end.

*And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a **thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.* Revelation 11: 3.

Is there also symbolism in the number **1260**? There certainly seems to be as demonstrated in the following gematria findings. In the last day Jesus will return in victory.

When (the time or season) I shall come in victory = עת בוא תשועה = 781 + 9 + 470 = 1260

I did not spend a lot of time looking for words with a value that would total 1260. However, when reviewing prophetic verses, as I was calculating the numerical value of the words I happened across some findings of interest. Returning to the verse in Joel which was previously used to show significance for the number 1290, I found support for 1260 being related to the end times. The only change from the verse is that I used an alternate interpretation of the word for “voice” which can also mean “call aloud” and deleted the word for “shall utter.”

And the Lord shall call aloud before his army: for he is strong that executeth his word = יהוה קול פנים חיל כל עצום עשה דבר = 206 + 375 + 206 + 30 + 48 + 180 + 136 + 26 = 1207

The numerical total is obviously not 1260, and it would not have been noticed by me if I had not first identified the numerical value as follows:

One thousand two hundred and sixty = אלף שנים מאה נשים = 650 + 46 + 400 + 111 = 1207

To lend further credence to the idea that the numbers stated in the prophetic verses of Scripture are symbolic of the end, look at the following, where the **word for “executeth” means “to fulfill or to finish.”**

And the Lord shall call aloud before his army: for he is strong that executeth = יהוה קול פנים חיל כל עצום עשה = 375 + 206 + 30 + 48 + 400 + 111 = 1001

Entire completion/consummation/ the end = συντέλεια = 1001

If this is not convincing enough, then consider the following which is from the exact words of prophecy regarding the Day of the Lord and judgment in Isaiah 13: 6.

Howl ye; for the day of the Lord is at hand; it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty = ילל כל יום יהוה קרוב בוא שד מן שדי = 314 + 90 + 304 + 9 + 308 + 26 + 56 + 30 + 70 = 1207 = One thousand two hundred and sixty.

The same can be shown for the words of the prophecy in Zechariah 14: 10-11:

In that day Jerusalem shall be lifted up and inhabited = הוא יום ירושלם ראם ישב = 312 + 341 + 586 + 56 + 12 = 1207 = One thousand two hundred and sixty.

One final example of gematria showing symbolism in the number of days mentioned in Revelation is the following:

The time of judgment is near = עת משפט קרוב = 308 + 429 + 470 = 1207 = One thousand two hundred and sixty.

As I had expected, the number of days mentioned until the end in both the Old Testament prophecy of Daniel and the New Testament prophecy by John in Revelation had symbolic meaning. Having been able to identify the symbolism in the numbers, which further proved the truth of the Bible and the validity of gematria, I thought that the extent of my personal revelation

was complete. It was not. I continued to have an unexplained obsession with thoughts of Scripture related to the end times. Even though I was not consciously trying to figure out the confusing passages of Scripture, ideas about how to pursue the matter constantly came into my mind. I prayed for further enlightenment and direction as I did not know how to interpret the prophecies.
